SUBJECT: CHANGE 2 -- PARTIAL Rescinding of CONUS Limited Evacuation Order (LEO)

1. The Limited Evacuation Order (LEO) published on 5 October 2016 is hereby **partially** rescinded for **ALL PERSONNEL, with the exception of those who are permanent residents of Beaufort, Horry, and Georgetown counties.** All evacuees not in those excepted counties who traveled as a result of the LEO may begin returning immediately and are expected to return to Joint Base Charleston NLT 2359 hrs on 10 October 2016. After arriving, utilize your chain of command for accountability and update your location in your Service accountability system. If unable to return safely or by the designated return time, personnel must notify their command for direction. Reimbursement under LEO provisions for all those not in the three excepted countries will end as of 2359 hrs on 10 October 2016. An order rescinding the LEO for those in the three excepted counties will be issued when safe return is assured. When appropriate, personnel should file vouchers in accordance with the Joint Travel Regulation (JTR). Additional guidance regarding travel vouchers will be published by the Joint Base Charleston Comptroller.
2. Failure to comply with this order is a violation of Article 92, UCMJ, for military members. DoD civilian employees in violation of this order may be subject to administrative discipline under applicable service regulations.
