MEMORANDUM FOR ALL JB CHS Hurricane Recovery Teams

FROM: Commander, Joint Base Charleston

SUBJECT: Revocation of CONUS Limited Evacuation Order (LEO) for Hurricane Recovery Teams

1. The Limited Evacuation Order (LEO) published on 5 October 2016 is hereby revoked for ONLY personnel detailed to **HURRICANE RECOVERY TEAMS**. Hurricane recovery teams are expected to begin travel back to Joint Base Charleston for arrival NET 0900 hrs on 09 October 2016. Any personnel not specifically detailed to a hurricane recovery team must not return at this time. Separate guidance will direct return for all additional personnel. After arriving, utilize your chain of command for accountability. If unable to return safely, hurricane recovery team members must notify commanders. Anyone unsure as to whether they are designated to the hurricane recovery team should utilize his/her chain of command. The LEO still applies to all individuals not assigned to a hurricane recovery team, including all families and dependents.
2. Failure to comply with this order is a violation of Article 92, UCMJ, for military members. DoD civilians in violation of this order may be subject to administrative discipline under applicable service regulations.
