FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q: Is Space A travel a reasonable substitute for travel on a commercial airline?

A: The answer depends on you! If your travel schedule is flexible and finances permit for a stay (sometimes in a "high-cost" area), while awaiting movement, space available travel is a good travel choice. While some travelers sign up and travel may be the same day, many factors could come together to make buying a commercial ticket your best or only option. Remember, Space A travel success depends on flexibility and good timing.

Q: What is the best time of the year to travel Space A?

A: Any time other than peak travel and holidays (December-January and June-July) periods.

Q: Do you have any recommendations on baggage?

A: Yes, you may check two pieces of luggage at 70 pounds each per person. You may hand carry only what fits under your seat or in the overhead compartment, if available. Travel light, take only essentials. Do not place valuables, medicine, or important documents in your check baggage. Be sure your name and current address are on and inside your bags. Terminals have baggage ID tags available for you to use.

Q: Can I have family members travel with another military member if given power of attorney, other releases, or authority?

A: No. Family members may only travel when accompanied by their sponsor (except EML, Emergency Travel, and Command -Sponsored Travel).

Q: Is it easier to go to some destinations?

A: Yes. Places where we fly often (Germany) are much easier than low frequency areas (Australia or New Zealand).

Q: Can my pet travel with me on a Space-A flight?

A: Unfortunately, the movement of pets is no longer authorized on AMC flights, not even for a PCS. The only exception is for those locations not serviced by commercial aircraft.

Q: Where can I get more information on Space-A Travel?

A: The best resource for information about Space-A Travel is to contact the nearest military passenger terminal. The terminal staff will have the most current information. If you plan to travel Space-A, contact the passenger terminal(s) where you plan to depart for current flight information and assistance.
